# COVID-19 VACCINE BOOTCAMPS

Healthcare providers and provider organizations can gain foundational knowledge and skills related to COVID-19 vaccine administration and distribution. Vaccine bootcamps include developing a process for identifying unvaccinated patients, how to embed reminders for vaccines, and strategies for overcoming vaccine hesitancy through culturally and linguistically appropriate methods.

# LEARNING COLLABORATIVES

Learning collaborative sessions offer a forum for healthcare providers to engage with peers and subject matter experts to help solve challenges related to COVID-19 testing, mitigation, vaccination, and management. Sessions are tailored to providers serving different patient populations including: children and adolescents, adults, and pregnant people.

# IMPLEMENTATION SUPPORT

The I-VAC podcast series, *Beyond the Needle*, is a Physician's Guide to Increasing COVID-19 Vaccination Rates

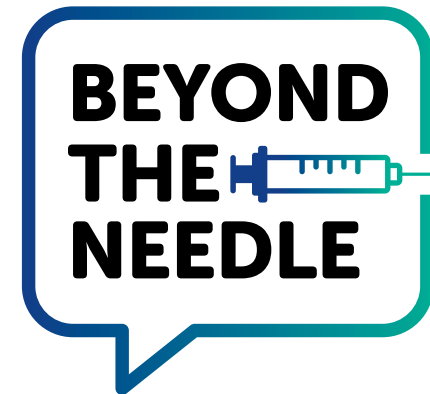
